



Abstract submission for ICREID 2020 will open on **October 18!**

The ICREID 2020 Scientific Programme Committee will begin accepting abstract submissions on October 18 for the March 2020 International Conference. Abstracts should have a focus around the theme **“EMERGING INFECTIONS AND ONE HEALTH”** and must be submitted to one of the following four major tracks – (1) One Health, Zoonosis and Emerging Infections, (2) Human, Environmental and Animal Health: The Interfaces of Health Security, (3) Innovations in Public Health, Laboratory Diagnostics, and Networking, (4) Role of National Public Health Institutes in Implementing One Health.

All abstracts will be peer-reviewed for scientific content and current relevance to the clinical, public health and laboratory community. Accepted abstracts will be presented from 18-20 March 2020 at the ICREID 2020 in Addis Ababa, Ethiopia, based on the following categories:
